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Abstract submission guidelines

- Abstracts must be in English
- Select the appropriate format of your presentation (workshop, oral or poster presentation, symposium)
- The maximum length for the abstract title is 20 words
- The maximum length for the abstract body is 300 words
- Indicate three keywords (MeSH terms when available)
- Abstract for oral and poster presentations shall include the sections:
 - Background & Aim
 - Method
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- Abstracts for workshop and symposium should include the sections:
 - Justification (Please explain the purpose of the activity)
 - Content (Please explain how to conduct the activity & the topics to be covered)

Workshops: 90 minutes

Oral presentations 15 minutes

Symposia 30 minutes or 60 minutes

Dead line for abstracts: March 1st, 2015

Invited key note speakers

Lecture: 20 minutes, discussion.- 10 minutes.
